Career Development

- **The Paramedical Program:** Six students were sponsored for Assistant Medical Lab Technician program .
- **CELT Program at Osmania University:** Four undergraduate students were sponsored for a 45 day workshop on soft skills at Centre for English Language Training (CELT) at Osmania University, Hyderabad.
- **Personalized Counseling:** Through personalized counseling R, who was BCom, BEd, joined as Teacher in a Dubai-based School.
T, who was BCom, counseled and groomed, joined as primary school teacher at Hyderabad Public School.
K was BPharm, he was first trained at CELT, and later counseled, and now he is working at Owaisi Hospital.

Career Development – Success Story

The first would be girl engineer from QN: HF passed her SSC in 2010 with 75% and Intermediate with 84% with Maths, Physics and Chemistry as her optional subjects. But she couldn't write the EAMCET Exam because (i) she couldn't collect her original mark sheet from her college as she was still due to pay them Rs 5000/- and (ii) her father refused to pay Rs 800/- towards entrance exam fee.

Ms HF was admitted into BE (Computer Science & Engineering) at a very concessional fee under management quota.

Good Luck HF! Thanks to Samaritans who have committed to pay her tuition fee for next four years. One year is already over!

We believe that HF will be the first girl engineer from this area in 2016!
